Grand Rapids Airport Access Study Phase 2 Survey Summary – GRR Employees


Overview

A total of 6,723 survey submissions were received, and responses came from nationwide participants who have traveled to or from the airport. This summary focuses on the 134 survey participants who selected "I work at the airport". Since all the questions are optional, not all recorded participants completed all questions. The survey was open on August 1, 2022 and closed on September 9, 2022.

Airport Access Improvements

What are the top 2 airport access improvements you would like to see?

More public transit and shuttle options to the airport and surrounding areas" and "Secondary access point from the north or west" are the top two improvements selected by survey participants. Other improvements mentioned in the comments include providing closer and more parking lot with bathrooms for airport employees.




What are the top 2 airport access improvements you would like to see?

Access Points from I-96/36th Street


This has an overall positive rating. Over a half of people selected "Like" or "Strong like" for this alternative.



Access Points from I-96/36th Street


Airport Access Points from Thornapple River Drive



Direct Shuttles Between Downtown Grand Rapids and the Airport









Distribution of survey participants' residential zip code




