




GVMC General Fund 2009-2022








REGIS Capital Account 2009-2022




FY2022 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)



Hardware Components

PROFILING SYSTEM

Capable of collecting profile data at speeds up to 75 mph (Height sensors and accelerometers combined help determine the IRI, or roughness profile of the road).



RUTTING

A five-point laser system meeting AASHTO requirements is capable of measuring changes in wheel path depth comparing the valleys and crests of a roadway profile.



Total cost: \$203k

Fed Share: \$166k (over 5 years)

GVMC Share: \$37k

FY22 Contract Revenue: \$60.5k

FORWARD/REAR VIDEO LOG IMAGES

Delivers up to 12 frames per second at 9 MP resolution.



GPS

Highly accurate position receiver/antenna provides positional accuracy in coordination with velocity and time data.




DISTANCE MEASURING UNIT (DMI)

Instrument capable of precisely measuring in increments of feet, miles, meters or Kilometers.





Nonmotorized Count Program Expansion



Pilot in FY2021: 19 peak hour, 3-day manual counts

FY2022: Utilized an automatic counter to take 24 hour, 7-day counts at 22 locations in the region


Developed a mapping application to provide count information to members and the public

Acquired a second counter at the end of the season that is also capable of taking bicycle tube counts




Airport Access Study

Regional Transportation Demand Management Plan

<u>Purpose</u>: Develop a plan to increase access to transportation options and create opportunities to make every trip faster and more efficient as our region grows and demand on our roadways increases.

Plan Objectives:

- 1) Foster regional coordination to unify TDM messaging and programming
- 2) Help people to live and work in the region get around without a car 2a) Use TDM programming to increase transit and vanpool ridership
- 3) Integrate TDM into infrastructure investments, land use policy, and parking decisions 3a) Educate key decision-makers on the benefits of TDM
- 4) Build relationships with employer partners to maintain the trip reduction benefits of flexible work locations and hours
