IV. FY2017-2020 TIP AMENDMENTS/MODIFICATIONS

Referring to Item IV: Attachment A, Joseph reviewed.

MDOT, KCRC, Grand Rapids, and Staff on behalf of Hope Network are requesting to amend/modify the FY2017-2020 TIP. The TPSG Subcommittee is also recommending action to program surplus STP-Urban funds. Here are the specific requests:

MDOT is requesting the amendments/modifications to the TIP project list and GPA projects in the attached JobNet summaries. MDOT is also requesting the review and approval of the 2019 Trunkline Road GPA threshold and associated projects.

Kent County Road Commission

KCRC is requesting to move a project from the illustrative list into the 2019 TIP that is being funded
with rural STP funds they've purchased from Montcalm County. It's not impacting funding from
any other project.

• City of Grand Rapids is requesting to modify an existing 2019 CMAQ project by adding local participating and non-participating costs. This will trigger a federal amendment for the 2019 Local Traffic Operations and Safety GPA, which will require committee approval.

• Staff, on behalf of Hope Network, is requesting to add a 5310 transit operations project to the 2020 TIP. Adding this job is also triggering a GPA threshold increase, which should be reviewed for approval.

Joseph discussed the local report pending projects. Most changes made for the FY2020 program reflect the FY2023 TIP; the years need to be consistent between the FY2017-2020 TIP and FY2020-2023 TIP. Most are amendment triggers for the programming decisions that were made. There were also a couple Ottawa County projects that were approved by the rural task force. Those projects are in the TIP because they are in the local planning area; there is no jurisdiction to their funds.

Joseph discussed the GPA Target Report and advised the committee that threshold increases would need to be approved for Trunkline Road, Transit Operating, Local Traffic Operations and Safety.

MOTION by LaFave, SUPPORT by Bradshaw, to accept the FY2017-2020 TIP AMENDMENTS/MODIFICATIONS as presented. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY

The TPSG Subcommittee had an emergency meeting on February 26, 2019 to program \$484,322 in 2019 STP-Urban funds that had not been part of the GVMC allocation at the time the FY17-20 TIP was originally programmed. Their recommendations were as follows:

- Allocate \$183,000 to the City of Grand Rapids Hastings Street project (Prospect to College reconstruction), which is currently significantly over-matched. New federal amount would be \$630,450 and the new local participating amount would be \$1,588,499. Total project cost won't change.
- Allocate the rest (\$301,322) to KCRC for their portion of the approach work on the 100th Street Bridge project. *This work is being done under the Trunkline bridge replacement project that is currently in the TIP, and therefore the funding would be transferred to an MDOT funding template.*
- o If for some reason the Grand Rapids is unable to make obligation in 2019, the subcommittee recommends flexing the unobligated amount to ITP to go toward the purchase of a bus.

DRAFT ITEM II: ATTACHMENT A

Joseph explained that after the TPSG Meeting changes were made. MDOT had discussions with MDOT in Lansing; they did not agree with that proposal. Due to the fact that local programs operate on a first come first serve basis. The MDOT project would now be listed as its own project and not part of the 100th Street Bridge project.

Kent advised that changes needed to be made of the proposed 100th Street Bridge Project.

Harrall added that he would like to keep it on the table for now and discuss at the Policy meeting, and if funds could not be obligated it would be defaulted to The Rapid.

MOTION by Conners, SUPPORT by LaFave, to approve the City of Grand Rapids request and to keep the other option open until the Policy Meeting. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY

V. NONMOROTIZED PROJECT LIST

Referring to **Item V: Attachment A** Joseph advised that they are preparing to get the Nonmotorized Subcommittee together to start recommending the pool of projects to go through the MGS process for possible funding with 2021-2023 regional TAP funds. According to GVMC's Policies and Practices document, "all nonmotorized projects requesting federal funds must be endorsed by the MPO to receive federal funds and be included in the TIP." One way to demonstrate this endorsement is by showing the project in GVMC's Nonmotorized Plan project list, which is illustrative in nature, but demonstrates the nonmotorized needs in the region. This is the list the committees use to choose the pool of projects that they recommend should move forward through the MGS application process with the eventual goal of receiving regional TAP funding as conditional commitments are awarded.

When we put out the call for projects for the FY2020-2023 TIP programming we got a few submissions for potential TAP projects that were not already in the NM Plan list, which led staff to send out an additional request for review of the NM Plan project list and submittal of any nonmotorized needs that had not been added since the last update. The list of project additions is attached for your review and action. Reminder, no funding is being committed to any new project at this point.

The goal at this time is to make sure all the needs are represented so that the NM Subcommittee will have everything in front of them when they start their recommendation process. We will do a thorough inventory update in the coming months when we get ready to start the MTP update process.

Joseph added that the City of Hudsonville added and changed the limits to an existing project and it was not on the project list.

Harrall added that the projects on the Non-motorized list should be listed by priority in case individuals are unable to attend meetings to discuss details.

Kent discussed the bridge/trail project.

MOTION by Harrall, SUPPORT by Strikwerda, to recommend the NONMOTORIZED PROJECT LIST to the Policy Committee. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

VI. UPDATED TIP LANGUAGE TO REFLECT PM 2 AND 3

Referring to **Item VI: Attachment A,** Joseph stated that, as part of the implementation of federal performance-based planning requirements, starting May 20, 2019, any updates or amendments to the TIP or MTP must be developed according to the performance-based provisions of 23 CFR Part 450 and the pavement and bridge condition and system performance and freight performance measure requirements.

This means that the MPO must update the "Performance Measures and Project Selection" chapter of the FY17-20 TIP document to reflect how we incorporated these performance measures into our programming process. Staff has drafted this additional language and is asking the Committee to review and provide comments; the modified chapter is attached and highlighted to show the new changes/additions. Action will be determined at the upcoming meeting.

Bradshaw asked if the fatality data on page 4-5 was accurate. Kent added his opinion on the fatality data.

Joseph advised to take action this month as the deadline is May 28th.

MOTION by Laughlin, SUPPORT by Bradshaw, to approve the FY2017-2020 TIP text amendment to incorporate additional performance measure requirements also to include the additional comments. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY

VII. STATE LONG RANGE TRANSPORTATION PLAN UPDATE

Kent – MDOT delivered a presentation on the status of the State's Long Rang Transportation Plan and provided a survey for the Committee/public to fill out.

VIII. <u>OTHER BUSINESS</u>

Faber advised that MDOT preformed an Air Quality Conformity Analysis for projects in our current TIP and Plan, as well as Holland and Muskegon's, and the STIP. It is available for public comment through Wednesday, March 20. We are well within out emissions budgets. Faber will be putting together a steering committee to help guide the direction of 2045 MTP, our long range plan, and asked the Committee to contact her if interested.

DeVries entertained a motion to adjourn the March 6, 2019 Technical Committee meeting at 10:20 am.

RE: FY2020-2023 Transportation Improvement Program

On behalf of all jurisdictions with projects programmed in the FY2020-2023 TIP, staff is requesting the recommendation for approval of the FY2020-2023 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) document by the Technical Committee in order to move forward with all necessary approvals by the Policy Committee, Grand Valley Metro Council (GVMC), the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT), the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA). The document is located on GVMC's website at this address:

The process to develop this document began in October 2018. Upon completion of the deficiencies analysis and call for projects the Transportation Programming Study Group (TPSG) and Rural Subcommittees met in December 2018 and began programming projects for the FY2020-2023 TIP. The result of that programming effort is reflected in the attached <u>preliminarily approved</u> FY2020-2023 TIP list of projects – which includes local, MDOT, and transit projects – as well as an Illustrative list of projects.

This list of preliminarily approved projects was used to for consultation, public involvement, environmental justice review, and air quality conformity analysis. The details of these processes and their outcomes are documented in the TIP document.

Based on work type and other guidelines, projects were either placed in a General Program Account (GPA) grouping (e.g. road resurfacing, bridge, transit capital, etc.) or included as an individual line item (e.g. reconstruction projects, major widening, etc.). The resulting 2020-2023 GPA thresholds are also included in this packet for review.

GVMC will take comments on the entire FY2020-2023 TIP document through June 6, 2019.

GVMC is the designated Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Grand Rapids metro area and is responsible for the development of the TIP, which is required by both FTA and FHWA.

It is the finding by GVMC that the transportation planning process implemented to develop the Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) and the TIP is certified in accordance with the requirements of US Code 23 CFR 450 and that the FY2020-2023 TIP is consistent with the Grand Rapids Area 2040 MTP and conforms to the State Implementation Plan (SIP) for air quality.

The current FY2017-2020 TIP remains in effect until the FY 2020-2023 TIP is approved by MDOT and the Governor, and has been found to conform to the SIP by FHWA and FTA.
